SEEK Building, Cremorne, VIC

Cremorne is a small inner suburb of Melbourne located approximately 2km south-east of the CBD. The suburb has a rich industrial past with many factories and light industry businesses being established in the early to mid-20th century. This was followed in the 1990s with the emergence of modern companies such as SEEK, MYOB, Disney and Carsales.

Project Design Brief

Urban designers wanted to effectively keep the level pavement areas free from surface water during rain events with a discreet heel friendly slot drain to run neatly along the paver lines.

ACO's Solution

- **KlassikDrain K100** with **Double Brickslot 100**

Benefits

- The 0.5% built-in slope of the KlassikDrain K100 system allowed the pavements to be constructed as flat as possible and still provide sufficient runoff to the outlets.
- The **Double Brickslot 100** top has narrow slots for heel safety.
- Access units allows entry for inspection and maintenance through a removable access cover that also has the same discreet drainage slot.
